



Connect the Dots

In the late 1800s and early 1900s, Blackford County was the site of a major oil and natural gas boom. People flocked to Starbuck City and Montpelier and areas like Swanton Field from 1886 to 1910 as they drilled for "black gold." Oil wells like this one peppered the county. People moved away when the resources ran out, but the population has risen consistently over the last 60 to 70 years.






